As per Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> above Government have notified 32 (ThirtyTwo) categories as Front Line Workers for prioritization for Covid -19 vaccination in the age group of 18-45 years as a first lot. As per Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above Government have notified 11 (Eleven) categories also as Front Line Workers for prioritization for Covid -19 vaccination in the age group of 18-45 years.

2. Since Government have received many requests from various Departments and also from General Public for vaccination priority, the matter for including more categories in priority group was discussed in the State Level Committee Meeting. Based on the suggestions of the State Level Committee, Government are pleased to notify the following categories too in the priority group for Covid -19 vaccination in the age group of 18-45 years .

- . Police trainee
- . Volunteers working in the field
- . Field workers of Meteorology Department
- . Field workers of Metro rail
- . Field worker of water metro
- . All above 18 years in Tribal colonies
- . Haj pilgrims
- . Bedridden patients of the age group between 18 and 44 & age group above 45 years

- . Ambulance drivers who have not taken vaccination yet
- . Bank employees (subject to the condition that the expenses for the vaccination should be met by respective banks themselves)
- . Medical representatives
- . Air India field officers
- . Judicial Officers and staff of High Court and Subordinate Courts
